- 1. We pray for girls who have been sold by their parents to traffickers. Heal their pain and draw them to know you as their loving and caring Father. (Rev. 21:4)
- **2.** Lord, we pray for integrity and accountability among the leaders of Bonaire, and we ask for justice to prevail in the island's governance. (Prov. 29:2)
- **3.** Jesus, you modeled for us how to live a life of loving others well. Awaken Christians in Brazil to follow you in caring for immigrants and refugees and the marginalized. (John 13:34)
- **4.** Indigenous women in Canada face a much higher risk of kidnapping and murder. Lord, protect and heal them and bring heart change to those committing this violence. (1 Pet. 3:12)

- **5.** Lord, we pray for good employment opportunities and fair wages for women in Chile. May they be valued for their talents and abilities. (Jer. 22:13)
- **6.** God, may programs and ministries be developed in Costa Rica that provide emotional, spiritual and practical support to women in need, especially single mothers. (Gal. 6:2)
- 7. Lord, we intercede for more women in Cuba to know Christ and be discipled, becoming living testimonies of his love and grace. (John 8:31-32)
- **8.** Father, comfort those who have emigrated from the Dominican Republic for economic reasons. Heal the pain caused by physical, emotional and spiritual distance from family and home. (Ps. 34:18)
- **9.** In your mercy, Lord, uproot the criminal violence within Mexico. May its people turn to you for restoration, consolation and the security they seek. (Joel 2:25-26)
- **10.** Lord, grant favor and grace to our team in Paraguay as they present projects to the national government and seek to creatively help vulnerable women there. (Ps. 5:12)
- **11.** Many families in Uruguay live in housing without water or electricity. God, grant their leaders the wisdom and resources to build quality homes, especially when children are involved. (Matt. 7:25)
- **12.** Father, may your Spirit of truth help young women in the U.S. to discover that in Christ alone there is no striving he is the source of their true identity. (John 1:12)
- **13.** Lord, we intercede for the safety of women in Venezuela who are facing domestic, gender-based or exploitative violence. Bring justice and restoration to their lives. (Ps. 72:14)
- **14.** Lord, we pray for economic growth on Bonaire so that businesses thrive and provide job opportunities for its people. (Phil. 4:19)
- **15.** God, grant wisdom and sensitivity to our TWR Women of Hope Brazil team as they produce content and strategize how to grow and publicize the ministry. (Col. 1:9)
- **16.** The majority of sex trafficking in Canada occurs in the "Highway 401 corridor" of Ontario. Lord, we pray for the organizations working to fight this exploitation. (Ps. 82:3)

- 24. Father, protect and heal girls on U.S. college campuses who have been sexually assaulted or exploited. Bring real change both to campus policies and the hearts of the perpetrators. (Isa. 60:18)
- 25. God, please provide food, medicine and essential resources to women in Venezuela amid this country's economic difficulties. (Deut. 15:11)
- 26. As Bonaire's population increases, there is a scarcity of affordable housing. May families be able to find and pay for a place to call home. (Ps. 127:1)
- 27. Father, we ask that all corruption be uprooted within Brazil so that the entire nation will be blessed with freedom and prosperity. (John 8:36)
- 28. God, may your Spirit guide Christian women in Chile to serve their churches and communities with wisdom and love so that they will positively impact their environments. (1 John 3:18)
- 29. Lord, may women in Cuba come together in community to support one another in prayer, friendship and practical help. (Acts 4:32)
- 30. God, may the rulers who took office last month in Uruguay fear you and seek you for wisdom as they govern this nation. (1 Tim. 2:1-2)

"Upholding women who face frightening change"

Have you ever considered how drastically a life can change in mere seconds? In the blink of an eye, the unexpected can comp letely redirect our lives. A marriage proposal, made and accepte d in under a minute, irrevocably alters a couple's future. The c onfirmation of pregnancy triggers a whirlwind of thoughts and emotions, a lifetime of possibilities flashing before a woman. In an instant, a mother-to-be understands she is embarking on a n ew path filled with emotion, adventure and hopeful anticipation.

While such changes bring immense joy, not all life alterations a re welcome. Some are frightening and destabilizing. A friend o nce said, "It seems God sometimes shakes our boat to shift us from one course to another." This perfectly captures the feeling of facing the unexpected. These "shakes" can range from a sim ple scare to being thrown overboard. In moments, skies darken, and a storm reroutes our lives. We know the unexpected is ine vitable, yet we are often unprepared when it occurs.

As we pray for women enduring the aftermath of war, natural disaster, poverty, economic crisis and other external forces, we are reminded of Naomi, a woman in the Old Testament who fa ced unimaginable misfortunes. Her life was marked by unexpected and unavoidable changes, demanding constant adaptation.

It is heartbreaking to consider the tragic memories that haunted her. Widowed while her children were young, she faced the da unting task of raising them alone. Later, when life seemed stabl e, another tragedy struck: the deaths of her sons. Alone with t wo widowed daughters-in-law, Naomi was forced to choose a n ew path, returning to her homeland. Ruth, one of her daughters-in-law, chose to accompany her. Naomi and Ruth returned to Bethlehem of Judah.

Their fresh start was difficult, requiring hard work and resilienc e, but their story has a hopeful ending. Ruth married and had a son, filling Naomi's heart with the joy of grandmotherhood. N aomi endured loss, sorrow and change, yet she remained steadf ast in her faith. The Lord provided her with wisdom, guidance and grace to navigate each challenge.

Thousands of women today share similar stories. We hear daily of wars erupting, natural disasters devastating landscapes, and living conditions drastically changing, causing the crushing pain of loss of both earthly possessions and loved ones. Forced to f lee their countries, they face the challenge of learning a new la nguage and adjusting to a new culture. Overnight, their comfort and security vanish. Fear, pain, confusion and insecurity become their constant companions. But there is hope. We can raise our voices to the Lord – who is a very present help in times of trouble – and ask for his assistance in every aspect of their lives, from learning a new language to building a supportive community. He offers physical, mental and spiritual healing.

The Lord used people in Naomi's restoration process. To this d ay, people still play a crucial role in the lives of those suffering. I am extremely thankful for your hearts of compassion. I ap preciate that you take time to present these women before the Father so they may have hope. This month, I also encourage y ou to seek ways to offer practical help to people around you. You may assist women in their language-learning process, lend your ears to listen to their traumas, use your voices to pray with them, or maybe simply offer the warmth of a hug. Your presence and concern will be a beautiful expression of God's love.

Thank you for walking with us. May you find comfort in know ing you are never alone: "For I am the Lord your God, who u pholds your right hand, who says to you, 'Do not fear, I will h elp you" (Isaiah 41:13).
